Report

At the request of Colchester Borough Council's Building and Architectural Services Department, a 1:1 scale drawing was made of a 1m x 0.6m area of masonry adjoining the southernmost of the pair of windows situated midway up the west side of Holy Trinity church tower. The record was made in September 2000, prior to small-scale masonry repairs.




Fig 2 The window reveal and adjacent west face.

A reduction of the drawing is appended (Fig 2), together with a photograph of the window at the time of recording (Fig 1). The original drawing and photographs will be deposited with Colchester Museum for permanent safekeeping under cover of Colchester Museum archive code 2000-31.


