# Report on the negative watching brief at Lexden tumulus, 30 Fitzwalter Road, Colchester, Essex

## Archaeological background:

The site is on the edge of the Lexden tumulus (a scheduled ancient monument); for summary see Crummy 1997, pages 22-5.

### Brief report:

# 1) November 2003

Observations made during the removal of a drainage pipe that ran along the west side of the tumulus (see figure). A tree bole was seen in section: in the 1970s, two of the Wellingtonia trees that surrounded the tumulus were removed, and this tree bole almost certainly dates from this time (see figure). In certain areas, part of the stratigraphy of the tumulus was also revealed. No other archaeological features were noted.

#### 2) March 2004

Observations made during the planting of two new trees in the projected locations where the two Wellingtonia trees stood before they were removed in the 1970s (see figure). The first hole (far north) was approximately 50 cm wide/long and 50 cm deep and it was dug through modern backfill (L1) associated with the removal of the pipeline (November 2003). The second hole was also approximately 50 cm wide/long and 50 cm deep and it was dug through 5 cm of modern backfill (L1), 10-15 cm of turf (L2) and topsoil (L3), and a mid/light silty brown subsoil (L4). No archaeological features were noted.




Fig 1 Plan of all the groundworks at Lexden Tumulus (November 2003 and March 2004).
