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1 Summary

A programme of historic building recording was carried out by Colchester Archaeological Trust on Braintree College, Bocking, Essex in August 2020.

The college complex consists of a large number of buildings and was constructed in the late 1950s or early 1960s. It was built in the brutalist architectural style, with strong geometric angles, exposed building materials and a strong focus on practicality over aesthetics. Several buildings were added to the college in the 1990s and are of a much more modern style, with pitched roofs and exposed timber-trusses.

2 Introduction (Fig 1)

This is the archive report of a historic building recording carried out on Braintree College, Bocking in advance of its demolition. The recording work was commissioned by M Scott Properties Ltd and was carried out by Colchester Archaeological Trust (CAT) in August 2020. The site is located on the east side of Church Lane, opposite the entrance into Coldnailhurst Avenue in Bocking, approximately 1km north of Braintree town centre, at NGR TL 76114 24344 (Fig 1).

A planning application (planning ref. 19/01743/FUL) was submitted to Braintree District Council in September 2019 proposing the demolition of the existing college buildings and the erection of a 75-bedroom care home and 19 new dwellings with associated site infrastructure.

In response to this application, the Place Services Historic Environment Advisor (HEA) recommended to the council that a Historic England Level 2 building recording be made of the buildings prior to their demolition. This recommendation was given based on the site having played a notable part in the education and lives of many of the local community. The recommendation was based on the National Planning Policy Framework (DCLG 2019).

A Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) for the building recording was prepared by Colchester Archaeological Trust (CAT 2020) and agreed with the HEA. All work was carried out in accordance with this WSI.

All work was carried out according to standards and practices contained in the Chartered Institute for Archaeologists' Standard and guidance for the collection, documentation, conservation and research of archaeological materials (2014a), Standard and guidance for archaeological investigation and recording of standing buildings or structures (2014b), Management of research projects in the historic environment (Historic England 2015), Standards for field archaeology in the East of England (EAA 14) and Research and Archaeology Revised: A Revised Framework for the East of England (EAA 24). In addition, the guidelines contained in Understanding Historic Buildings: A guide to good recording practice (Historic England 2016) were followed.

3 Aims

The aim of the building recording was to provide a detailed record and assessment of the buildings prior to their demolition. The building recording was carried out to Level 2 (Historic England 2016) which is defined as:

"...a descriptive record, made in similar circumstances to Level 1 but when more information is needed. It may be made of a building which is judged not to require a more detailed record, or it may serve to gather data for a wider project. Both the exterior and interior of the building will be seen, described and photographed. The examination of the building will produce an analysis of its development and use and the record will include the conclusions reached, but it will not discuss in detail the evidence on which this analysis is based. A plan and sometimes other drawings may be made but the drawn record will normally not be comprehensive and may be tailored to the scope of a wider project."

In particular the record considered the:

- Plan form of the site.
- Materials and method of construction.
- Date(s) of the structures.
- Original function and layout.
- Original and later fixtures and fittings.
- Significance of the site in its immediate local context.

4 Methodology

The following are included in this report:

- A documentary, cartographic and pictorial survey of the evidence pertaining to the history and evolution of the site.
- A large-scale block plan of the site.
- Annotated and phased floor-plan of the buildings at a scale of 1:400.
- A description of the buildings. The description addresses features such as materials, dimensions, method of construction and phasing.
- A photographic record, comprising digital photographs of both general shots and individual features. Selected examples of the photographic record are clearly tied into the drawn record and reproduced as fully annotated photographic plates supporting the text. The photographic record is accompanied by a photographic register detailing location and direction of shot (Appendix 1).

5 Historical background (Fig 1)

The following historical background draws on cartographic sources, the Essex Records Office (ERO) and the Essex Historic Environment Record (EHER) accessed via Heritage Gateway (www.heritagegateway.org.uk). Newspaper archives of the *Braintree and Witham Times* were also consulted.


The structures detailed in this report form the majority of the campus of Braintree College (Fig 1).

The historical and archaeological background of the area surrounding the college was examined in detail in a recent Heritage Impact Assessment (CAT Report 1281) and so is only summarised here.

The campus is located within a historic area of post-medieval and medieval settlement at Bocking. It is located immediately to the north of a conservation area following Church Street, and is surrounded by several listed buildings. Prominent among these, and immediately to the west of the college, is Boleyns, a 17th-century Grade II* listed timber-framed and plastered house (EHER 27982, NHLE 1170835).

The site was founded as Braintree College of Further Education in the late 1950s-early 1960s, and most of the buildings were constructed at this time, although some appear to be much more recent, as examined below in the descriptive record. In 2010 the college merged with Colchester Institute and switched to providing vocational courses and promoting apprenticeships, over strictly academic courses.

The college first appears on the 1955-71 OS map (Map 1).

Although many of the current college buildings are present on the 1955-71 map, there are some that are not (Fig 1). The footprint of the college is much the same on the subsequent 1980s OS maps, and it is not until the 1992 map that the newer buildings in the complex are visible, suggesting these structures were added to the college in the early 1990s (Map 2).

Since the college's founding, it has garnered several famous alumni including the artist Grayson Perry, the astronomer Lisa-Harvey Smith, the TV presenter Jeremy Spake, the indie band Missing Andy, the actress Nadine Lewington and the musician Olly Murs.

6 Building recording descriptive record (Figs 2-4)

The college buildings have not been in use for over a year and, as a result, they have become quite derelict, with large sections of water-damage on the upper-floors and several instances of vandalism. As a result many features do not, or only partially, survive and where this is the case it is noted in the descriptive record below.

Exterior

The college buildings comprise several varying ranges (Photograph 1). Overall they cover approximately 5,530 square metres and are a prominent landmark in the north of Bocking. The 1950s-1960s buildings (those visible on the 1955-71 OS map) are all constructed of grey reinforced concrete or red brickwork, laid in stretcher-bond (Photograph 1). All of the roofs of the original buildings are flat.

The later additions to the complex (Fig 2) are constructed of a mixture of yellow and red brickwork (again laid in stretcher-bond) and largely have gabled roofs covered in pan-tiles (Photograph 2), although some of the smaller additions (and the visual arts block) have flat roofs (Photograph 3).

The principal building in the complex is a large, five-storey tower block located on the eastern end of the site (Fig 2, Photograph 4). All of the buildings have modern metal or plastic-framed fixed awning windows with large panes. The five-storey tower in particular has a large number of awning windows on every floor (Photograph 4).

As well as the main complex of buildings, there are structures on the periphery of the site, including a bungalow, sheds, store rooms, a large electrical and gas substation (with two large brick chimneys adjacent; Photograph 5) and a visual arts block (Fig 2).

Interior

The college has a vast number of rooms of varying uses, including classrooms, lecture halls, a theatre, a gym, offices, dark rooms, stairwells, W.Cs, storerooms and a library. Many of the classrooms were generic, with no indication as to their purpose. Enough signage and surviving educational accoutrements survived in some areas, however, to accurately assign classrooms to their subject (Figs 2-4). During this survey several rooms were inaccessible, either due to their derelict nature or simply because their doors were locked.

Universally the rooms of the college are of modern design, with lowered ceiling-panels and often floored with carpets or vinyl-panels, and have little in the way of notable features or fittings. The rooms are not here described individually, as that would be a lengthy and redundant exercise. Instead, specific rooms deemed noteworthy, or features or fittings of interest, are recorded below, while the remainder of rooms are labelled on the accompanying plans (Figs 2-4). Additionally, each room in the college is numbered (Figs 2-4), and where a room is described below that number will be referenced.

The ground-floor of the college (Fig 2) contains several large communal rooms. These include an entrance foyer (room A95G, Photograph 6) and a lecture theatre (room A7, Photograph 7) to the east of the building. In addition there is a hall and stage to the south of the complex (rooms A75 and A75E respectively, Photograph 8). In the centre of the complex is a library (room A40, Photograph 9) and dining hall (rooms A49-50, Photograph 10), these being two of the larger rooms in the college.





In the newer 1990s section of the college is a large student common room (room A57), to the south-west of the complex (Photograph 11). It is notable for its several exposed substantial timber trusses, all bolted together (Photograph 12).



The classrooms on the ground-floor of the main college building appear to comprise three main types; an area of carpentry workshops (rooms A25-A31), an area of mechanical workshops (rooms A9 and A17-A24) and some plumbing workshops (rooms A10-14 and rooms A34-A35). These rooms were mostly identified by the remaining fixtures and fittings, including displays detailing the profession in question. The mechanical workshops had large horizontal sliding doors leading to the outside to allow the entry and egress of vehicles (Photograph 13), whereas in the carpentry workshops several examples of timber-frame construction were on display (Photograph 14). One of the plumbing workshops had a series of imitation bathrooms which would have presumably been used for testing and training purposes (Photograph 15).

On the western side of the college is a stand-alone art block, containing a pottery studio (room C13, Photograph 18), and two dark rooms (rooms C6 and C6a, Photograph 16) along with several other rooms. This art block is a single-storey and has multiple large sun-lights in its roof, which is supported by large metal-beams spanning the entire building (Photograph 17).

The bungalow to the south-west of the site has several rooms equipped for residential use, including a kitchen (Photograph 19).

The electrical and gas substation to the west of the complex has large amounts of machinery and switchboards inside, as well as a large water tank (Photograph 20).

The first-floor of the complex (Fig 3) is split. The first-floor to the south, above the hall and stage, comprises of faculty offices for the college staff. Most of these were locked, but the ones that were accessible were unremarkable. The first-floor to the north of the complex comprises more classrooms, including electrical workshops (rooms A129-130, Photograph 21), an art studio (room A122, Photograph 23) and a chemistry lab (rooms A113-A114, Photograph 22).

The second-floor (Fig 4) has several other varied classrooms, including a kitchen workshop (room A203), a photography room (room A209) and an art history room (room A210).



The third, fourth and fifth-floors of the tower block largely consist of IT suites and online examination rooms, with a selection of storage cupboards and server rooms (Photograph 24, Fig 4). At the very top of the tower block is a separate room containing two large water tanks and access onto the roof (Photograph 25).





The stairwells leading up to the upper floor of the college are all heavily lit with large windows and quite substantial in size (Photograph 26). This is as would be expected from a building designed to allow the movement of large numbers of people in short spaces of time (as would happen several times during the college's working day). This design philosophy is also carried over into the corridors of the college.

In several locations around the buildings are artistic murals, all presumably undertaken by students of the college (Photographs 27-28).

7 Discussion

Braintree College is a classic example of late-modernist, brutalist architecture. This style of architecture first rose to prominence in the 1950s and consisted of buildings with bold geometric alignments and exposed construction materials, and is renowned for an extreme focus on practicality over aesthetics. With its swathes of exposed concrete and brickwork, and uncompromising rectangular buildings and rooms, the original phase of Braintree College fits neatly into this architectural style, which was often used for public buildings in the mid-20th century.

Brutalism as an architectural style becomes increasingly unpopular in Britain after the 1970s, and the subsequent buildings added to the complex in the 1990s reflect a much more modern sensibility and a deliberate attempt to be more pleasing aesthetically. The pitched roof and large trusses of the student common room (pg 8) are ample examples of this, as is the extensive use of large single-pane windows throughout the newer elements of the college.

Although unquestionably of tremendous importance to the local community and the students who studied here (producing, as it has, several notable alumni in both the arts and sciences), the college buildings themselves hold little in the way of architectural or historical merit. Although the importance of brutalism as an architectural style is starting to be acknowledged (and Historic England has begun to list extraordinary examples), the buildings at Braintree College are of little interest, particularly in their current state.






Fig 1 Site location, with surveyed buildings highlighted.




Fig 4 Second, third, fourth and fifth-floor plans of college, showing room use. Location and direction of photographs reproduced in text shown.
