Nature of the work: Observation of groundworks for a single-storey extension.

Reason for condition: The development site is located 30m from Lexden Mount (Scheduled monument 1019963, MCC1536), a Roman barrow.

% of total seen: 100% of the groundworks.

Results: The following groundworks were monitored by a CAT archaeologist in response to a brief set by Dr Richard Hoggett of Colchester Borough Council Planning Services.

A total of 18.71m of foundation trenching was mechanically excavated through modern topsoil (L1, *c* 0.22-0.30m thick, loose dry medium grey/brown sandy loam) into natural sands (L2, soft moist medium orange/brown sandy silt). The trench was 0.50m wide and up to 0.90m deep.

Nothing of archaeological significance was uncovered but a modern service was present.




Photograph 1 Service in trench – looking north-east




Fig 2 Results.




Fig 3 Representative section.
