Results	Results		

The following groundworks were monitored by a CAT archaeologist in response to a brief set by Dr Simon Wood of Colchester Borough Council Planning Services. The WSI was written by John Newman Archaeological Services, who was unable to carry out the fieldwork.

The foundation trenches for the extension totalled c 20m long, c 0.5m wide and 1.05m deep. Four horizons were observed:

- bedding sand from the former patio (L1, 0.2m thick) overlay
- a layer of buried modern topsoil (L2, 0.3m thick) which sealed
- made-ground (L3, 0.5m thick) with
- natural clay beneath (L4, identified at a depth of c 1.0m deep)

Concrete foundations from demolished structures were recorded in four different locations (see Fig 2).

Five metres of service trench was excavated through topsoil (L5) which led to the soakaway (2m by 1.5m and 1.6m deep). Topsoil (L5) sealed natural (L4) within the soakaway, and a large modern pit (F1, 1.2m deep) was full of broken flower pots and other modern garden waste.

Context details

L1, bedding sand

L2, buried modern topsoil of soft, dry, medium orange/brown silty-loam

L3, made-ground of firm, dark brown/black clayey-loam, which produced a single fragment of Roman brick (328g).

L4, natural clay and gravels

L5, modern topsoil of soft, medium brown silty-loam


F1, modern pit of soft, medium brown silty-loam with a dense concentration of broken flower pots and other garden waste.





Photograph 1 Foundation trenches, looking north-east




Fig 3 Feature and representative section.
